EDC PLANNING & ZONING LIAISON COMMITTEE SPECIAL VIRTUAL Meeting Minutes Monday, April 10, 2023 Wallingford, CT 06492

The EDC Planning & Zoning Liaison Committee special virtual meeting was called to order by Chairman Baum at approximately 8:33 a.m. Commissioners Wolfe, Baum and EDC Staff Member Mirra were in attendance.

- 1. Discussion and possible action on May 18, 2022 Special Virtual Meeting Minutes Jim Wolfe made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Hank Baum seconded the motion. Minutes were unanimously approved.
- 2. Discussion: Planning & Zoning Commission Special Meeting item regarding the possible reduction of minimum parking requirements in the Town Center (TC) District.
 - Baum stated that the PZC is not discussing this item at their next meeting. The committee continued their discussion. After discussions the committee feels that they are suggesting .75 spaces/1-2 bedroom unit and 2 spaces/3+ bedroom units. The committee will compose a letter to submit to the PZC prior to their May Workshop. Committee will recommend that the EDC commissioners attend the workshop.
