

It appears that at this time there will be a primary election held on August 14, 2018, for both the Democrats and Republicans. Voters are reminded that Only Democrats may vote in the Democratic Primary and only Republicans may vote in the Republican Primary.

Voters are reminded that May 14th is the last day for those registered with a party (including minor parties such as Green, Independent or Libertarian) to change their Party affiliation and vote in the primary of their choice. It requires 90 days to register in a different Party.

Voters who are unaffiliated must register with the party of their choice by August 9th, 2018, to vote in that party's Primary

Qualified individuals may request an application for an Absentee Ballot from the Town Clerk at 203-294-2145. You must already be registered with either the Democrat or Republican Party
