WATER CUSTOMERS

The Water Division will continue its annual water main flushing program and will be flushing on a Monday through Friday schedule between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

This flushing program will remove harmless deposits of accumulated rust and sediment and is necessary in order to improve and maintain water quality.

The area to be flushed beginning Monday, May 20, 2019, will be the following:

Zone 3: Center St., Hall Ave., So. Main St., Grandview Ave., So. Whittlesey Ave., So. Orchard St., So. Colony St., So. Cherry St., East St., Quinnipiac St., Ward St., So Turnpike Rd., Cook Hill Rd., Jones Rd., Mansion Rd., Nod Brook Rd., Spice Hill Condos., Brentwood Village Condos., Olde Oak Village, Juniper Landing, Heritage Woods Condos., and all other streets in these areas.

Zone 4: Constitution St., Christian St., No. Elm St., No. Main St. and Ext., Church St., High St., North St., Barnes Ind. Rd. South, No. Colony St., Yale Ave., No. Cherry St. and Ext., Washington St., No. Plains Ind. Rd., No. Plains Hwy., Pent Hwy., and all other streets in these areas.

Flushing of these areas should take about six weeks.

Important: Please check the condition of the water before use, since discoloration of the water and lowered pressures may occur during flushing.

This notice will also be carried by Government Access Channel 20 on Comcast Xfinity or Position 99 on Frontier TV and the Wallingford Town website (www.town.wallingford.ct.us at "News/Announcements" of "Water Main Flushing Program") and will be updated as necessary.
