**ELECTRIC SERVICE
RENEWABLE ENERGY CHARGE ADDER
RATE NO. 14**

APPLICABLE:

To all customers receiving metered electric service from the Electric Division.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

The energy provided through this adder is produced exclusively by renewable sources, such as wind, landfill gas, and/or small hydro-electric sources.

RENEWABLE ENERGY OPTIONS:

Customers who elect to be subject to this rate shall have the option of purchasing either all (100%) of their energy or one-half (50%) of their energy from renewable sources. Customers who choose the 100% option shall pay a charge computed by multiplying all of the customer's kilowatt-hours billed (measured or estimated) by the Renewable Energy Charge in dollars per kilowatt-hour (\$/kWh). Customers who choose the 50% option shall pay a charge computed by multiplying all of the customer's kilowatt-hours billed (measured or estimated) by one-half of the Renewable Energy Charge in dollars per kilowatt-hour (\$/kWh).


All customers participating in this Rate shall pay the appropriate renewable energy charge adder as defined and calculated above in addition to all other applicable charges.

RENEWABLE ENERGY CHARGE:

The Renewable Energy Charge shall be as provided to the Electric Division by its full-requirements wholesale energy provider, the Connecticut Municipal Electric Energy Cooperative (CMEEC).
