# TOWN'S BUDGET FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009

The following is a record of the minutes of the Wallingford Town Council at a Special Public Hearing Meeting for the Budget of Fiscal Year 2008-2009 held on Thursday, April 24, 2008 in the Robert Earley Auditorium of the Wallingford Town Hall. Town Council Chairman Mike Brodinsky Called the Meeting to Order at 6:22 P.M. Responding present to the Roll Call given by Town Council Secretary Sandra Weekes were Councilors Michael Brodinsky, Nick Economopoulos, John LeTourneau, Robert F. Parisi, Rosemary Rascati, Michael Spiteri and Vincent F. Testa. Councilor Gerald E. Farrell, Jr. arrived at 6:25 P.M. and Councilor Vincenzo M. DiNatale arrived at 7:35 P.M. Mayor William W. Dickinson, Jr., Town Attorney Janis Small and Comptroller James Bowes were also present.

A Moment of Silence began the meeting. The Pledge of Allegiance was said and the Roll Call taken.
